WEM Water Park —5 tickets per family—\$200 (one time purchase per family)

Pirate Registration Fee \$355, includes PPAC shirt and 2 caps, as well as a \$80 credit that can be put towards gear package purchased at the Wahoo Swim School—see group gear requirements.

Annual Financial Commitment

-  Each fundraiser you participate in earns money towards your families AFC and benefits the Team. No Required BINGO commitment—although Bingos are available for \$75 per session.
-  Approximately 25% of all fundraising efforts go towards a capital campaign to buy equipment for the team—this year the aim is for touch pads and a new timing system. Recent efforts have allowed the Pirates to succeed in getting a new scoreboard, starting blocks, and headwall.
-  Every family (pre-comp & above) is required to buy 5 WEM Water Park Tickets at Registration, but above and beyond the Water Park Tickets an additional fundraising commitment is required as per the AFC policy, with a family maximum of \$2000.

Training Fee, Installments & Early Withdrawal

-  Pay in Full or by Installments. Installments are billed September 15th, December 1st, and March 1st.

-  Siblings receive 5% discount on training fee.
-  NSF fee of \$25 will be charged to each non-sufficient fund that isn't addressed within 7 days.
-  No refunds or transfers will be given for registration, installments, meet fees, bingos, or fundraising.
-  In the event someone wishes to withdraw a 30-day written notice is required and a 10% admin fee (10% of annual training fee) will be applied to the account.

Before Swimmer(s) Can Enter the Water

All registration fees need to be paid.

Registration with Swimming Canada (SNC) needs to be completed, SNC will email you to do the following:

- 🏊 set-up/update your account.
- 🏊 verify your information (DOB).
- 🏊 sign-off on SNC policies.

PPAC requires a parent from each household to receive a certificate from Safe Sport Canada (good for 5 years)

Swim Meets

- 🏊 Swim meets are held approximately every 3-5 weeks.
- 🏊 Coaches will enter all eligible swimmers—this can be viewed on the Team website.
- 🏊 Swimmers entered will receive an email with meet details and deadline.
- 🏊 Parents can contact their child's coach to deselect from a day/session they cannot attend.
- 🏊 Swim Practice will not be available for swimmers who have an opportunity to attend a swim meet and choose not to go.

Meet Fees

- 🏊 Swimmer must be registered as a competitive swimmer with Swim Alberta to compete.
- 🏊 Each competitive swim meet does have an associated fee, which will be charged to the online account via CC around the time of competition.
- 🏊 Meet fees are non-refundable after the entry deadline set by the PPAC.
