

Learn to Swim with Copley Aquatics

Private and Semi-Private Lessons are available year-round at our facility, Simmons Natatorium at Copley High School. As an adult or for your child, the student will work one on one or in a small group setting with one of our experienced instructors.

Our Instructors are each trained as lifeguards with additional certifications such as Red Cross Water Safety Instructor, USA Swimming certified coach, certified classroom teaching, and years of swimming experience.

The details:

Private lessons start at \$35-50 per 1/2 hour private session.

Private lessons for 2-children in the same family at the same session starting at \$50-60.

Semi-private group lessons with 3 or more swimmers start at \$30 per swimmer.

- Our starting fees are the baseline cost of any lesson. As our instructors are highly qualified, each instructor may charge a higher fee within our Copley Aquatics, LLC. (CAQ) guidelines.
- Each participant must have a waiver on file with CAQ.
- All participants and guests must follow all natatorium policies, policies given from management, lifeguard staff and instructors. We reserve the right to cancel your lessons or remove you from the facility if policies are not followed.
- A deposit equal to the cost for your lesson is required to reserve your session. This will be used as payment for your first lesson or debited if you do not keep the appointment within the cancellation guidelines.
- *Cancellation policy:* Please give 24 hours cancellation notice. You will be charged for the session if notice is given under 12 hours.
- *Payment:* Payment is due at the time of service. Your instructor may collect payment before the lesson begins. Payment is given directly to your instructor and preferred is cash or check. Your instructor may also accept Venmo or Apple Pay. Your session may be invoiced from CAQ by credit card and includes a \$3 service fee. Natatorium Policies & FAQ's

1) Do I swim with my child?

In most cases, no. We do offer a parent-child lesson with parents in the water but for the typical lesson, it is just the instructor and the participant.

2) Should I be on deck with my swimmer?

Parents on deck during practice is a liability and safety issue. The policy against such a practice is in place to prevent distractions for the coach(es) as well as the athletes. The only individuals that should be on deck during a practice are the USA Swimming coach members and those individuals the coach(es) deems necessary to assist in conducting the practice. *No street shoes are permitted on deck.*

3) Where are you located?

The HS is located at 3807 Ridgewood Rd. Copley, Oh 44321. The pool is attached to the main building with an entrance on the West side of the building. These doors lead to the main gym and the parking lot leads to the stadium at the other end. Park near the building and enter through the glass doors marked "POOL." You will see the Natatorium door open just as you step inside on the left. Take those stairs up to get checked in for the lesson. You can also enter the locker rooms from that hallway by walking past the first door and you'll see the Men or Women signs and the doors open to those locker rooms.

Often, our side door is open *for ventilation*. Please do not use this door to enter our facility. For safety, we limit "street shoes" on the pool deck. Locker Rooms: Are open & include showers. Sandals/shower shoes are

required in the locker rooms. Please avoid changing in the bathroom stalls. In the Stands: We require that *no wet swimmers* enter the stands. For their lesson, please drape your child's towels over the railing for them to dry off. The stands become very slick when wet so we keep this as a dry area.
