



STINGRAYS

UNIFORM POLICY

Much like any sports team that would take the field wearing their team uniform, the Stingrays expects each of its athletes to be outfitted in its team attire. This includes, but is not limited to **JAKED** branded team wear, swim suits, t-shirts and swim caps.

TRAINING

- **Any Stingrays Cap** to be worn at all training sessions.
- **Team Stingrays Attire** is encouraged to be worn during training sessions & must be worn during training camps and off home-site training sessions.
- **Yellow Stingrays Cap** to be worn during all Open Water Sessions.

COMPETITION

- **Stingrays Attire** should be worn at all competitions.
- Please wear your **Stingrays T-Shirt** to all meets as below.
 - **White** on Day 1 & **Black** on Day 2
- **Stingrays Swimwear** (*Suit, Trunks or Jammers*) to all swim meets for warmups, cool downs.
- **Swim Caps:**
 - If it is a Heat Declared Winner Event, then the Blue Stingrays Cap should be worn.
 - For example: HKASA, Home Meets – **Blue Stingrays Cap**.
 - If it is a Heat and Finals meet, then the White Stingrays Cap should be worn at Heats, and the Blue Stingrays Cap worn at Finals.
 - For example: QLD, Open Meets, Championship Meets
 - Heats – **White Stingrays Cap**
 - Finals – **Blue Stingrays Cap**
- Please wear **Stingrays Attire** if receiving awards on podium, talking to media or for team photographs.

RACING TECH SUITS

At each level of competition, Stingrays has a policy governing which suits are allowable. As a guideline, tech suits should be worn at national meets (HKGSA D1+) level and beyond and for swimmers ages 13+. Coaches will give specific racing suit requirements for each swim meet.

BACKPACKS

Swimmers at all group levels are expected to carry the Stingrays Swim Bag by Jaked when they attend swim meets, competitions, training camps, or any events at outside venues. Swimmers who go on Team Travel must also carry the Large Traveling Back Pack by Jaked.

ORDERING AND IMPLEMENTATION

In an effort to show unity and comradery, we ask that all swimmers abide by the Uniform Policy. Swimmers who wish to compete in local and overseas swim meets starting the Fall 2021 season must wear the new **Stingrays Jaked Team Attire**.

Any swimmer who does not wear proper Stingrays team uniform may risk being unable to take part in the competition.
