

POOL RULES

- Guests must follow the directions of the facility staff at all times. Individuals who do not comply will be asked to leave the aquatic center.
- There are no cell phones or devices capable of photography/video allowed in lock rooms.
- Clean bathing suits are required – No cutoffs. Any other exemptions (religious or otherwise) must be approved before entering water.
- All children must be potty trained (AKA no diapers).
- Healthy skin is required per state law. Admission can be denied to anyone with an infection, inflammation, or contagious disease of the skin.
- Patrons who have had a stomach virus resulting in diarrhea within the last two-week period are not allowed in the pool.
- Patrons should be responsible for cleaning up after themselves/throwing items in the trash.
- Lockers may be used for the time patrons are in the facility. Any lock used must be removed upon leaving. Any lock left on a locker will be cut off and will not be replaced.
- We are not responsible for personal items that are stolen or damaged while in our facility.
- Patrons must walk on the pool deck.
- No diving. Patrons must enter the water feet first.
- Children 13 or younger must be accompanied by an adult.
- Unnecessary roughness is not permitted in or around the pool area, this includes the use of water guns.
- Roped areas are for lap swimming only unless designated by a lifeguard for other use (i.e. water aerobics).
- No breakable objects such as glass or ceramic allowed on the pool deck or in the pool.
- Per state law, no alcohol, E-cigarettes, tobacco, or firearms possession/use are allowed in or on school district property.
- No chewing gum allowed.
- Clothing or body art (i.e. tattoos) that is indecent, offensive, or overly distracting is not acceptable. Inappropriate or offensive patches, writings, or images on clothing, or patrons are prohibited. Patrons will be asked to cover up or remove images on clothing that are in violation of this policy.
