



ATHLETE CODE OF CONDUCT

The purpose of a code of conduct for athletes is to establish a consistent expectation for athletes' behavior. By signing this code of conduct, I agree to the following statements:

- I will respect and show courtesy to my teammates and coaches at all times.
- I will demonstrate good sportsmanship at all practices and meets.
- I will set a good example of behavior and work ethic for my younger teammates.
- I will refrain from unacceptable behavior such as, but not limited to:
 - Bullying
 - Lying
 - Bad Language
 - Drugs/Alcohol/Vaping
 - Gossiping
 - Stealing
- Swimmers who exhibit sexist, racist, homophobic, or otherwise inappropriate behavior will be faced with disciplinary action.
- I will show respect for all facilities and other property (including locker rooms) used during practices, competitions, and team activities.
- I will conduct myself in a manner that would not detract from the positive image of St. Cloud Thunderbolts Aquatics and its members, or the City of St. Cloud. This includes in person interactions as well as on social media.
- If I disagree with an official's call, I will talk with my coach and not approach the official directly.
- I will abide by all of USA Swimming's rules and codes of conduct.

Corrective Action Procedures:

1. Coach will discuss the matter, in person, with the athlete and follow up with parents via email.
2. Coach will conduct an in person meeting with athlete and parents.
3. Disciplinary review board consisting of Coach, Head Coach, and President to determine course of disciplinary action.
